- ASA DataFest was founded at UCLA in 2011 when 30 students gathered for 48 intense hours to help fight crime through an analysis of every arrest record of the last 5 years as provided by Lt. Thomas Zak of the Los Angeles Police Department.
- ASA DataFest™ is now sponsored by the American Statistical Association and is hosted by some of the most prestigious colleges and universities around the world.

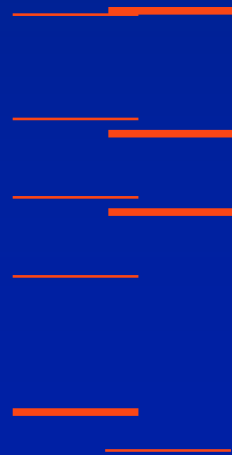
